### ENGLISH BREAKFAST

### EARL GREY

Gillards blend of this world famous tea is exclusive, hand blended using a selection of finest China Teas and carefully infused with oil of bergamot orange. Named for Charles, 2nd Earl Grey, British Prime Minister 1830-1834 who was reputedly given some tea flavored with bergamot-probably a diplomatic gift. Earl Grey is best taken black or with a slice of lemon.

### JANE AUSTEN BLEND

Named in honor of the world famous novelist, a resident of Bath and reputed tea-lover. Gillards of Bath, long standing blend recreates three fine China teas into a delicate tea that was enjoyed throughout the 18th Centur. This delicate tea is best served without milk.

### LADY WHISTLEDOWN
